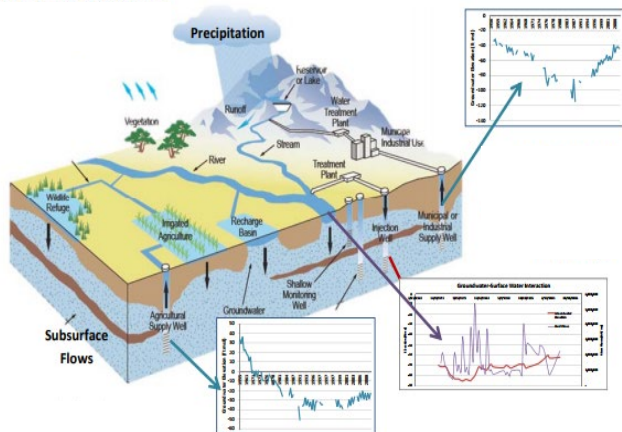

This workshop will include presentations on the current status of basin characterization including the Hydrogeological Conceptual Model (HCM), the definition of current groundwater conditions, and a water budget for historical (1995-2014) and current (2015) conditions. Key SGMA elements

- Basins must be managed by GSAs
 - The White Wolf GSA formed in 2017
- GSAs must develop GSPs; GSPs for medium priority basins like the White Wolf Subbasin are due January 2022
 - White Wolf Subbasin is working on the draft “Plan Area” and “Basin Setting” portions of the GSP
- Basins must achieve clearly-defined sustainability criteria within 20 years of GSP adoption
 - Performance assessment: The GSP will be updated and reviewed every five years
