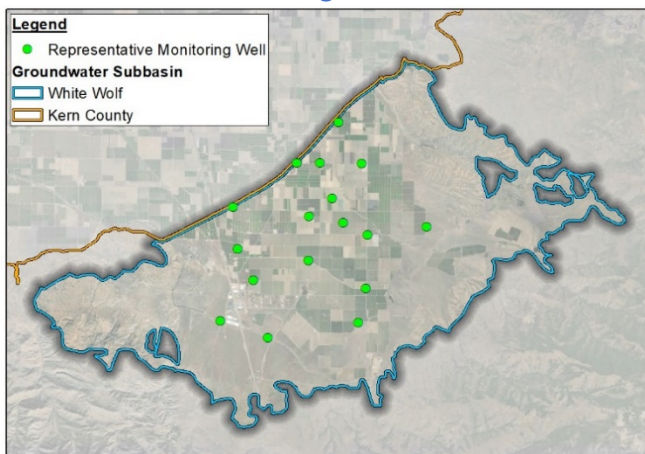

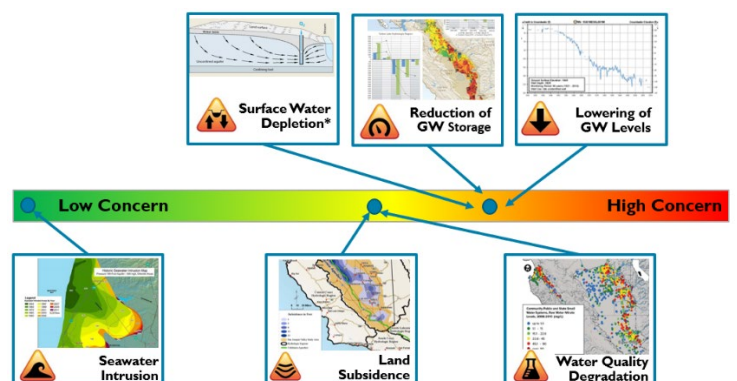
## Key SGMA elements

- Basins must be managed by GSAs
  - ☑ The White Wolf GSA formed in 2017
- GSAs must develop GSPs; GSPs for medium priority basins like the White Wolf Subbasin are due January 2022
  - ☐ White Wolf GSA is working to draft chapters of the GSP
- Basins must achieve clearly-defined sustainability criteria within 20 years of GSP adoption
  - ☐ Performance assessment: The GSP will be updated and reviewed every five years.
