MINUTES OF THE REGULAR BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

Date of Meeting: Tuesday, January 6, 2026

Location: Remote and In-Person

Meeting Commenced at 7:30 a.m. with the pledge of allegiance.

DIRECTORS PRESENT: Tito Martinez, Dolores Salgado, Trey Irwin, Colby Fry, Jeff Mettler

DIRECTORS REMOTE: None

DIRECTORS ABSENT: Jeff Giumarra

PUBLIC AND STAFF: Alanna Godell from DWR, Christina Lucero, Sarah Gerenday, and Anona Dutton from EKI, Robert Velasquez, Eric McDaris, Ryo Takanashi from Water One, Sheridan Nicholas, Michelle Nop, Jeevan Muhar, and Legal Counsel Alan Doud.

Chairman Martinez did a recognition of guests. Chairman Martinez continued to the review of the draft meeting minutes of the Regular Board Meeting of November 4, 2025. On motion by Director Colby, and seconded by Director Salgado, the minutes were approved unanimously.

Robert Velasquez presented the financials starting with an explanation of the capital call, as well as a forecast of cash position to help determine when the next cash call will be. It was decided to time the cash call on an as needed basis and potentially by the end of January or later. On motion by Director Irwin and seconded by Director Mettler, the financials were approved unanimously.

Ms. Martin informed the Board that DWR had not yet paid Grant Invoice #6 as stated in the last board meeting. Invoice #6 was still pending, and Grant invoice #7 had been submitted to DWR.

Christina Lucero presented the November and December groundwater levels, with no exceedance to MT's, and water levels trends between November and December showed an increase of 0-5 feet. Fall water levels were uploaded to the DWR website as required by SGMA. She then reported on SMCs revisions and the potential methodology for updating GWL IM. Christina also presented an analysis of the land use trends in the last 20 years. Director Martinez was interested in knowing what the water use changes were based on the land use trends, and if it was surface or groundwater. She also talked about the land subsidence SMC, explaining the land subsidence in the WWB is minimum, ranging between .02-.25 feet. This is based on use of the InSAR data, which has some limitations. She also talked about the potential options for land subsidence SMCs. She then continued to talk about water quality SMCs. Director Martinez recommended forming an Ad-hoc committee to work on water quality SMCs. It was agreed that the Ad-hoc committee be formed by one member from each district, being Director Martinez, Director Irwin, and Director Colby. There was further discussion regarding the available monitoring network for water quality. She then continued to present Interconnected Surface Water and SMC context, and its existent monitoring network.

There was no correspondence to report.

There was no public comment.

Next regular board meeting is scheduled for February 3, 2026.

There was no closed session.

On motion by Director Salgado, seconded by Director Colby, the White Wolf GSA meeting was adjourned at 8:34 a.m.
